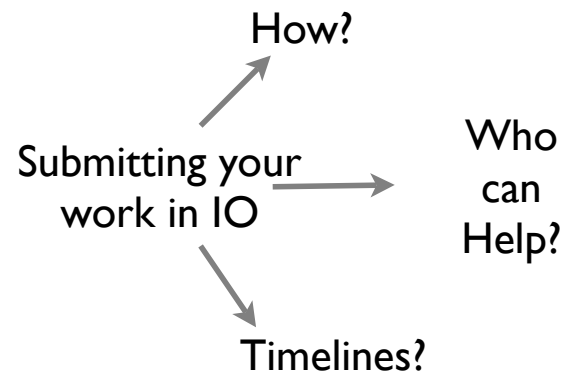

Sample Questions:

- How has globalization impacted individuals and communities in the urban environment?
- What has been the economic, environmental and social impact of globalization on the urban environment?
- How has globalization impacted our identity?

Questions driving inquiry

- What impact is globalization having on our community?
- How is the globalization changing our understanding of 'community'?
- What new understandings of 'community' have emerged due to the forces of globalization?
- What economic, social, and environmental issues have emerged in our community due to the forces of globalization?
- What might we predict for the future in our community due to the forces of globalization? acting on our communities?
